EXPERIENCE

"Pastor, I feel a distance between me and God, and this is stopping me experiencing His presence. What have I done wrong?" First, you must understand that there is never any separation between you and God - even though it may feel like it at times. The Bible makes this truth very clear, the Lord said, *"I will never leave you or abandon you"* (Hebrews 13:5). Jesus promised, *"I am with you always"* (Matthew 28:20). Therefore, we can experience God's presence anytime and anywhere. Hebrews 4:16 says, *"Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need."* Whenever we need help, we can boldly come into God's presence to receive mercy and find grace. There is only one condition attached to this incredible experience, and that is, we must enter through the shed blood of Jesus.

A father desires nothing else but to experience and share as much as he can with his children. He treasures every moment with each individual child. Likewise, God wants to experience everything with you. In John 5:19 Jesus said, *"I only do what I see My Father do."* Every experience was shared with His Father before He implemented it! We can all do the same! Enter the throne room of grace in the confidence that you will be received with open arms, and then experience the love of the Father. God wants to share every moment of every day with you.
