

50 HEALING SCRIPTURES

If you will keep the “healing Word” before your eyes, complete healing is guaranteed to come. ***“My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes; keep them in the midst of your heart; for they are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh”*** (Proverbs 4:20-22).

1. **Genesis 20:17**, “So Abraham prayed to God; and **God healed** Abimelech, his wife, and his female servants. Then they bore children.”

2. **Exodus 15:26**, “If you diligently heed the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For **I am the Lord who heals you.**”

3. **Exodus 23:25-26**, “So you shall serve the Lord your God, and He will bless your bread and your water. And **I will take sickness away from the midst of you.** No one shall suffer miscarriage or be barren in your land; I will fulfil the number of your days.”

4. **Deuteronomy 7:15**, “And **the Lord will take away from you all sickness**, and will afflict you with none of the terrible diseases of Egypt which you have known, but will lay them on all those who hate you.”

5. **Deuteronomy 32:29**, ‘Now see that I, even I, am He, And there is no God besides Me; I kill and I make alive; I wound **and I heal**; Nor is there any who can deliver from My hand.

6. **Psalm 30:2**, “O Lord my God, I cried out to You, And **You healed me.**”

7. **Psalm 91:9-10**, “Because you have made the Lord, who is my refuge, Even the Most High, your dwelling place, no evil shall befall you, **nor shall any plague come near your dwelling.**”

8. **Psalm 103:1-5**, “Bless the Lord, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name! Bless the Lord, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, **Who heals all your diseases**, Who redeems your life from destruction, who crowns you with loving-kindness and tender mercies, Who satisfies your mouth with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle’s.”

9. **Psalm 107:19-20**, “Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, And He saved them out of their distresses. **He sent His word and healed them**, And delivered them from their destructions.”

10. **Proverbs 4:20-23**, “My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart; For they are life to those who find them, And **health to all their flesh**. Keep your heart with all diligence, For out of it spring the issues of life.”

11. **Isaiah 53:4-5**, “Surely He has borne our griefs; And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And **by His stripes we are healed.**”

12. **Isaiah 55:9-11**, “For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts. For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, And do not return there, But water the earth, And make it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower And bread to the eater, So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And **it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.**”

13. **Isaiah 57:19**, “I create the fruit of the lips: Peace, peace to him who is far off and to him who is near,” Says the Lord, “And **I will heal him.**”

14. **Isaiah 58:9-11**, Then you shall call, and the Lord will answer; **You shall cry, and He will say, ‘Here I am.’** “If you take away the yoke from your midst, The pointing of the finger, and speaking wickedness, If you extend your soul to the hungry And satisfy the afflicted soul, Then your light shall dawn in the darkness, And your darkness shall be as the noonday. The Lord will guide you continually, And satisfy your soul in drought, And **strengthen your bones**; You shall be like a watered garden, And like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail.”

15. **Jeremiah 17:14**, “**Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; Save me, and I shall be saved, For You are my praise.**”

16. **Jeremiah 30:17**, ‘For **I will restore health to you and heal you of your wounds,**’ says the Lord, ‘Because they called you an outcast saying: “This is Zion; No one seeks her.”’

17. **Ezekiel 47:9**, “And it shall be that every living thing that moves, wherever the rivers go, will live. There will be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters go there; **for they will be healed**, and everything will live wherever the river goes.”

18. **Malachi 3:6**, “For I am the Lord, I do not change; therefore **you are not consumed.**”

19. **Malachi 4:2**, “But to you who fear My name, The Son of Righteousness shall arise with **healing in His wings.**”

20. **Matthew 4:23-24**, “And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.** Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and **He healed them.**”

21. **Matthew 7:7-11**, “Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. **For everyone who asks receives**, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent? If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give **good things to those who ask Him!**”

22. **Matthew 8:7**, And Jesus said to him, “**I will come and heal him.**”

23. **Matthew 8:16-17**, “When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and **healed all who were sick**, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: “**He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses.**”

24. **Matthew 9:35**, “Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom and **healing every sickness and every disease among the people.**”

25. **Matthew 12:15**, “But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and **He healed them all.**”

Matthew 14:14, “And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and **healed their sick.**”

26. **Matthew 15:30-31**, “Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus’ feet, and **He healed them.** So the multitude marvelled when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.”

27. **Matthew 21:14**, “Then the blind and the lame came to Him in the temple, and **He healed them.**”

28. **Mark 1:34**, “Then **He healed many who were sick with various diseases**, and cast out many demons; and He did not allow the demons to speak, because they knew Him.

29. **Mark 11:22-24**, So Jesus answered and said to them, “Have faith in God. For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, **believe that you receive them, and you will have them.**”

30. **Mark 16:17-18**, “ And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; **they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.**”

31. **Luke 4:17-19**, And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written: “The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to **heal the brokenhearted**, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and **recovery of sight to the blind**, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.”

32. **Luke 4:40**, “When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and **He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them.**”

33. **Luke 5:17**, Now it happened on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. And **the power of the Lord was present to heal them.**

34. **Luke 6:19**, And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for **power went out from Him and healed them all.**”

35. **Luke 8:47**, “Now when the woman saw that she was not hidden, she came trembling; and falling down before Him, she declared to Him in the presence of all the people the reason she had touched Him and **how she was healed immediately.**”

36. **Luke 9:1-2**, “Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to **cure diseases**. He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to **heal the sick.**”

37. **Luke 10:8-9**, “Whatever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you. And **heal the sick there**, and say to them, ‘The kingdom of God has come near to you.’”

38. **Luke 13:16**, “So ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound—think of it—for eighteen years, **be loosed from this bond** on the Sabbath?”

39. **Acts 3:7-8**, Then Peter said ... In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk. And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: and **immediately his feet and anklebones received strength**. And he leaping up stood ... walking, and leaping, and praising God.”

40. **Acts 4:29-30**, “Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, **by stretching out Your hand to heal**, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus.”

41. **Acts 5:15-16**, “So that they brought the sick out into the streets and laid them on beds and couches, that at least the shadow of Peter passing by might fall on some of them. Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and **they were all healed.**”

42. **Acts 8:7**, “For unclean spirits, crying with a loud voice, came out of many who were possessed; and **many who were paralysed and lame were healed.**”

43. **Acts 9:34**, And Peter said to him, “Aeneas, **Jesus the Christ heals you.** Arise and make your bed.” Then he arose immediately.

44. **Acts 10:38**, “How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and **healing all who were oppressed by the devil**, for God was with Him.”

45. **Acts 28:8-9**, “And it happened that the father of Publius lay sick of a fever and dysentery. Paul went in to him and prayed, and **he laid his hands on him and healed him.** So when this was done, the rest of those on the island who had diseases also came and were **healed.**”

46. **Galatians 3:13**, Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, **having become a curse for us** (for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”).

47. **James 5:13-16**, “Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing psalms. Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him,

anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And **the prayer of faith will save the sick**, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.”

48. **1 John 5:14-15**, “Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, **He hears us**. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.”

49. **3 John 2**, “Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things **and be in health**, just as your soul prospers.”

50. **Revelation 19:16**. “And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: **King of Kings and Lord of Lords**.”
